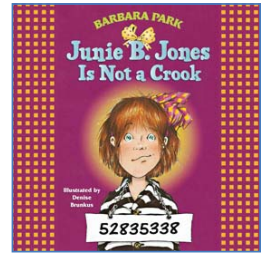

The Exhibition

In 2004, National Geographic photographer Tim Laman and Cornell University Lab of Ornithology scientist Edwin Scholes began a series of 15 targeted expeditions to document these bizarre birds. After eight years and 37 distinct geographic locations, they completed the first comprehensive study of all 39 known species of birds-of-paradise.



Found only in New Guinea and parts of Australia, the birds-of-paradise are a case study in the evolutionary power of sexual selection. Their fantastic plumes and bizarre courtship displays result from millions of years of sexual selection at work in an environment with plentiful food and no natural predators.

This exhibition encompasses video footage, photographs, artifacts, and interactive experiences to create a science exhibition, art show, and natural history display all rolled into one!
