Find luck on the rails during the Grapevine Vintage Railroad's "Kiss Me I'm Irish Express." On Saturday, March 17, this unique St. Patrick's Day event will feature festive fun, including green beer to commemorate this most Irish of celebrations. The train departs out of the Grapevine station at approximately 7 pm and returns to Grapevine around 9 pm. (Train does not travel to Fort Worth Stockyards.)



Seating is assigned upon check-in. All groups or guests that wish to ride together must check-in at the same time to ensure they are seated in the same coach. Changes cannot be made in seating assignments after boarding passes are issued.

Boarding passes may be picked up at the Grapevine Cotton Belt Depot, 705 S. Main St. Boarding will begin at 6:40 pm and the train will depart promptly at 7 pm – rain or shine. Please arrive 30 minutes prior to boarding to pick up your boarding passes. No refunds will be issued for missed trains. The train will return at approximately 9 pm.
