That's Amoré. Undoubtedly one of the most romantic spots in DFW, the **Mandalay Canal in Las Colinas** is an intimate, Venice-like waterway nestled along the shores of Lake Carolyn. Take in gorgeous views of waterfalls or a romantic dinner cruise at sunset for two, then retire to nearby accommodations at the Omni Mandalay or the Four Seasons. The only catch about this Venice-inspired excursion? The folks at Gondola Adventures encourage couples to kiss under every bridge.

Take the Ride. Unless you've been living under a rock, you've probably spotted the orange, green and yellow bicycles around town, either clustered in central locations or awkwardly parked near an intersection. For someone hoping to impress—or be impressed by—their significant other, the **Rosewood Mansion on Turtle Creek** has it all: award-winning fine dining, picturesque guest suites, a legacy of sophistication and impeccable service for which The Mansion is known. If you are feeling especially fancy, go all out and turn Valentine's Day into a Valentine's stay; because after a multi-course meal and a few bottles of wine, who wouldn't want to retire to a luxurious suite at The Mansion? One word to the wise: reservations for the restaurant's Valentine's Day dinner service tend to fill quickly, so booking a time slot in advance is highly recommended and less expensive.

Rooftop Romance. Fort Worth's small-town charm never ceases to make an impact. **The Live Oak's** well-established local community of musicians and fans gives this rooftop bar and music venue a sense of authenticity to go alongside the selection of North Texas beer on tap. Should the weather disagree with your patio plans, head to **Jazz Scat Lounge** downtown to take shelter in one of the best places to see live music in Dallas-Fort Worth, period.



Perot Museum

Calling all North Texans to sharpen their minds! The Perot Museum of Nature and Science rings in the new year with a bundle of brain-boosting experiences to entice all ages, including an oh-so-cool space exhibition, a "grossology" sleepover and a month focused on the innovations of engineering.

Can't get to space in the near future? Not to worry. The Perot Museum has a hands-on, climb-aboard adventure, as the 10,000-square-foot *Journey to Space* traveling exhibition continues to orbit. Guests can experience first-hand what it takes to work in the hostile environment of space and get the sensation of zero gravity by climbing aboard two massive rotating simulations of the International Space Station Destiny module.



Journey to Space: Through May 6, 2018

3...2...1... Lift off for fun! What's it like to live and work in space? How do astronauts sleep in a weightless environment, or go to the bathroom in orbit, and what effect does space travel have on their bodies? Presented in English and Spanish, *Journey to Space* is a hands-on adventure for all ages that takes guests as close to space as one can get from Earth. At 10,000 square feet, *Journey to Space* features two "climb-aboard" massive rotating labs that provide a glimpse of what it looks and feels like to be on the International Space Station Destiny module. Visitors can launch a rocket, test gravity in a drop tower, sit on a space potty, control a robotic arm, check out Neil Armstrong's authentic gloves from his Apollo 11 mission and more. Plus, young cadets will have a blast at the space station activity area. The exhibition is presented locally by Highland Capital Management and requires a surcharge.

January 19 - February 25, 2018

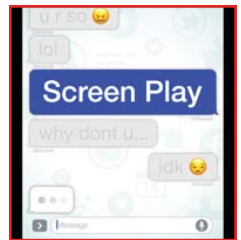
