Dallas Holocaust and Human Rights Museum

Founded in 1984 by a group of Dallas area Holocaust Survivors, the Dallas Holocaust and Human Rights Museum is dedicated to teaching the history of the Holocaust and advancing human rights to combat prejudice, hatred and indifference. Located in Dallas' Historic West End, the Museum hosted more than 80,000 visitors in 2018, among them 34,000 school children. A top-rated attraction in North Texas, the Museum is one of just a few Holocaust-related museums or centers in the United States and the only Holocaust museum serving North Central Texas, as well as the adjacent states of Oklahoma, Arkansas and Louisiana. The Museum has been recognized for its compelling and creative programming, internationally recognized exhibits, and world-class speakers.

Programs and services include:

- Permanent and special exhibitions of the highest caliber, with docent-assisted and self-guided tours;
- Holocaust Survivors' testimonies shared with thousands of Museum visitors and school groups each year and Survivor presentations to organizations throughout the region;
- Hundreds of school tours conducted for students grades 6-12;
- Upstander Speaker Series bringing renowned speakers on human rights issues to the DFW community;
- Civil Discourse Series presenting multiple sides of thought-provoking topics through respectful discussion;
- Subject matter experts available to speak to schools and community groups;
- A rich archive and research library available to Museum members and researchers;
- Digitized testimonies of Holocaust Survivors and Survivors of other genocides available for viewing in the library.

Irving Arts Center

The Irving Arts Center serves as the creative hub for the Irving community, hosting over 1,000 events every year, including live performances, rotating art exhibits, and activities for kids.

A Smithsonian Affiliate, the Irving Arts Center has earned a national reputation as a premiere arts venue. With four distinct galleries, it typically hosts more than 20 exhibits per year, showcasing a wide range of artistic styles and media. In addition to local and nationally recognized artists, the Irving Arts Center features traveling collections from the Smithsonian Institution.



The center also showcases outdoor works in its impressive 2-acre sculpture garden with beautiful walkways, fountains, and original works of art, including a pictorial mosaic created by local Irving students.

Fun for the Kids

Open seven days a week, the Irving Arts Center is the perfect place to spend the day with the kids. The youth and family programs include story times, live performances, summer camps, and more.

On the first Thursday of every month, the Center offers a free performance series just for kids, JumpstART Stories & Art. During this time, kids are given the chance to create their own works of art before exploring the galleries and sculpture garden. For more excitement, Family Fundays, held on the second Sunday of every month, provides additional chances for children to get a hands-on experience with art.

With so many engaging ways to explore and learn about art, kids are sure to love their time at the Irving Arts Center. The Museum of Illusions in Dallas' West End

Dallas has a new museum, and it's one that will make your head spin. The Museum of Illusions, an interactive museum focusing on "edutainment," opened its first Texas location in downtown Dallas on December 7 at 701 Ross Ave.

The museum features more than 60 exhibits and installations designed to offer an insight into how the brain perceives things. It uses illusions to teach visitors about vision, perception, the human brain, and science, making it easier to understand why the eyes can see things that the brain cannot explain. It includes such photogenic exhibits as a vortex tunnel, reverse room, tilted room, infinity room, a Beuchet chair, and more.



Open every day from 10 am to 8 pm, the museum costs \$19 for adults, \$17 for students or military with valid ID, and \$15 for children ages 5-12; kids 4 and under are free. There is also a family four-pack available for \$62, saving \$6 for a family with two parents and two kids.

The Museum of Illusions can also be booked for private and corporate events, as well as school excursions across all grade levels.
