Addison Weekend Drive-In

The city of Addison will introduce Addison Weekend Drive-In in July, offering two weekends of free live music to patrons in a drive-in environment at 15499 Julian St., just south of Addison Circle Park. The concerts, scheduled for July 17-18 and August 14-15, will replace Addison After Dark, a more hands-on interactive entertainment series that had been scheduled through November at Addison Circle Park. The latter series will return in 2021.

At Addison Weekend Drive-In, guests will be able to listen to live music from a variety of Dallas-Fort Worth bands from the comfort of their vehicles or in lawn chairs next to their cars. The music will be transmitted via both speaker system and FM radio.

“We are excited to invite our guests back to the Addison Circle Park District for live entertainment,” said Addison Director of Special Events Jasmine Lee in a statement. “Our team has worked to create a fun and safe way to enjoy live music here in North Texas and using the vacant lot south of Addison Circle Park provides the perfect location.”

The concerts, each of which will take place from 8:30 pm to 10 pm, will include the following bands:

- **July 17:** All Funk Radio Show (old school R&B, Motown, funk, pop)
- **July 18:** D City Rock (classic rock)
- **August 14:** Extended PLAY (top 40)
- **August 15:** Joseph Veazie (pop, R&B, top 40)

Parking for the concerts will open at 7:30 pm nightly, and cars will be directed to safe distances. Guests are asked to remain in or near their car during the entire performance.

Day Trips from Dallas

Texas offers plenty of dreamy destinations that are just a day trip away. We've rounded up a few accessible options to help you ease back into traveling in the summer months ahead.

Fossil Rim

Driving through 1,400 acres of forests and hills, and spotting roaming zebras, giraffes, and emus (the wildlife center is dedicated to conservation), you could easily forget that you're just one-and-a-half hours from Dallas.



Dinosaur Valley State Park

Dinosaur Valley is another must-visit site when you travel to Glen Rose. You can literally stick your feet in fossilized dinosaur tracks, camp, hike, swim, fish, and more. There's an entrance fee of \$7 per adult, but kids under the age of 12 can explore for free.

Beavers Bend State Park

If you need a nature-filled break from the city, Beavers Bend State Park in Broken Bow, Oklahoma is a great place to escape. Just around three hours northeast of Dallas and three-and-a-half hours from Fort Worth, the drive is short enough to head up in the morning, catch some scenery, hiking, and canoeing before heading back home.



Turner Falls Park

Another spectacular nature site in Oklahoma, Turner Falls boasts the biggest waterfall (77 feet) in the state. The park is open for swimming, camping, hiking, cave exploration, and views of the Arbuckle Mountains. Just be sure to purchase tickets online ahead of time.

Waco

If you haven't yet visited Chip and Joanna Gaines' famous Magnolia Market, add a Waco day trip to your summer itinerary. The market has reopened to 50 percent capacity inside of the buildings, where all staff are required to wear masks and one-way traffic flow is marked where necessary. Make sure you stop at Silos Baking Co. for cupcakes, cookies or pastries before heading into the shopping market.
