## Mule Alley Adding New Super Saloon, Coffee Shop and Live Music Brewery

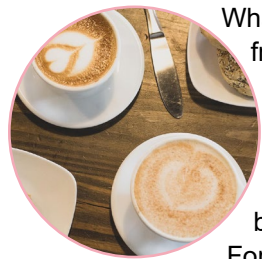
Fort Worth's revamped hotspot is growing up—2021 is going to be a big year in the Stockyards.

Mule Alley plans to gallop into 2021 with the addition of notable new restaurants/bars, a music venue and more. February and March are shaping up nicely for the revamped destination in the Fort Worth Stockyards, with three new expected openings.



First up is a craft-cocktail and wine bar from Sarah Castillo and the team behind Taco Heads and Tinie's Mexican Rotisserie. The Neon Light District Hospitality group will add an "elevated watering hole" to Mule Alley with the long anticipated **Sidesaddle Saloon**.

Sidesaddle Saloon ([www.instagram.com/sidesaddlesaloon](http://www.instagram.com/sidesaddlesaloon)) pays homage to the spirit of the American cowgirl, who long before pants were acceptable attire for women, would ride with both legs to one side of the horse—sidesaddle. Expect curated cocktails and Texas-style tapas in a rustic-modern, brick-walled, neo-saloon setting.



What is Mule Alley missing? A frothy dose of caffeine. That's why beloved Fort Worth-based artisanal coffee roastery—**AVOCA Coffee Roasters** ([www.avocacoffee.com](http://www.avocacoffee.com))—will be opening its third location in Fort Worth's Mule Alley in mid-February as well.

Finally, restaurateur duo Jason and Amanda Boso plan to open **Second Rodeo Brewing**: brewpub meets live music hall. Second Rodeo is part bar, brewery, and outdoor bar-garden.

# Dallas Contemporary: Japanese Artist Yoshitomo Nara Brings His Monumental Museum Show to Dallas

Most of the artworks in the Dallas Contemporary show were made in the last two years. The exhibition includes several impressive large-scale paintings on wood. There are several older works, the oldest dating back to 2006. The work in this show is more casual and free in appearance and technique. There are references to popular culture, the street, activism, and music. Many of the works are painted on everyday materials such as wood or cardboard. It is less formal, more youthful in spirit. They also have a wonderful selection of new sculptures in bronze that were made for this show and have never been exhibited before.



Since rising to global prominence in the 1990s, Nara has used his signature style to portray subjects in complex and ambiguous emotional states, ranging from rebellion to loneliness and quiet contemplation. Inspired by music, current events, and his childhood memories, among other subjects, his internationally celebrated works critically fuse contemporary issues with longstanding artistic traditions from East Asia and Europe.
