Mandalay Canals Paddleboarding in Irving

For a new and exciting adventure, **Stand Up Paddle North Texas** offers a different kind of tour around Lake Carolyn and the **Mandalay Canals**. Paddleboarding is just what it sounds like. It’s a water sport where a paddle is used while standing up on a surfboard.



Whether a novice or an old pro, visitors won’t be left hanging ten. SUP provides the board and paddle rentals, as well as a top-level training session and support for every age and skill level, so everyone can have

fun in the sun. Lessons are very

thorough and provide the basic techniques needed to safely stand up, paddle and balance. Whether there’s a breeze, slight waves or varied water conditions, visitors learn turning, sculling, drawing and multiple paddle techniques. They even explain what those terms mean. Gaining the necessary skills to paddle with confidence and safety, visitors can paddle alone or in groups of up to 60 people.

Imagine gliding across the water at sunset, taking in the sights and sounds of Lake Carolyn. SUP offers a three-hour sunset paddle tour on Saturday evenings. Paddling gingerly through the Mandalay Canals, past waterfalls and fountains, breathtaking views await as the sun’s rays take a final bow for the day.

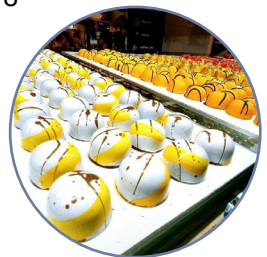

This 1,197-foot-wide phosphorescent mammoth falls within the boundary of the proposed 200-acre Harold Simmons Park which will be the largest urban park in the United States once completed (ground breaking is scheduled for 2022.) Topgolf Mini-Golf Course - North Dallas

Fort Worth Zoo presents New Elephant Wonderland

The zoo is opening its newest habitat Elephant Springs, which includes multiple lush, green spaces and various watering holes for Asian elephants and greater one-horned rhino to roam. Elephant Springs brings new spaces, renovated habitats, merchandise locations, restrooms and most importantly, new ways to observe, interact with and learn about these majestic animals.

Way beyond a mere renovation, this new elephant habitat almost triples the size of the zoo's old one. It will be the home of the zoo's remarkable Asian elephant herd, which includes a three-generation family. It's as much about the comfort, care and, most importantly, the breeding of the herd as it is about the enhanced viewing for the more than one million visitors who enjoy the zoo and participate in its education programs each year.

"We have seven members of the Asian elephant herd, four females and three males, and two of them are considered juveniles. The habitat is designed with continuous enrichment opportunities for them to mix and mingle and move as a herd, much as they would in the wild."

There is even a shaded demonstration area with seating that will be activated soon, so visitors can enjoy watching the zookeepers and elephants interact in regular "training" exercises. The exercises give visitors prime viewing, zoo keepers up close time to inspect the elephants from trunk to tail and stimulating/relational activity for the animals themselves

The primary pool is 400,000 gallons of refreshing bliss for the herd, with colorful plantings and naturalistic rock outcroppings, four waterfalls, additional water features and even water cannons that let kids



interact directly with the elephants. They can spray them with streams of water, which the elephants enjoy.
