Dallas Arboretum Offers Special \$2 Admission for August Dollar Days

ZimSculpt sculpture exhibition included with admission

The Dallas Arboretum announces the return of August Dollar Days during the dog days of summer. For the entire month of August, the garden offers \$2 general garden admission, \$2 admission to the Rory Meyers Children’s Adventure Garden and \$5 for parking. Named one of The Country’s Most Gorgeous Botanical Gardens by House Beautiful, the Dallas Arboretum has many floral beds blooming with impatiens, lobelias, begonias, salvia, marigolds, zinnias, caladiums, lantana, cannas, vinca and pentas.



Visitors can also see what’s growing in A Tasteful Place, the Arboretum’s 3.5-acre potager garden, pavilion and kitchen inspired by the movement toward growing and eating fresh, sustainable, locally-grown food. Guests are welcome to free samples of the “hero” vegetable daily. On Mondays, Dallas College offers a free 11 am cooking demonstration, and more activities occur throughout the month.

Advanced timed tickets are required for entry to the Arboretum by calling 214-515-6615 or visiting the website at www.dallasarboretum.org. Visit dallasarboretum.org or social media sites for the latest information.

Now through August 8, a highlight of Summer at the Arboretum is *ZimSculpt*, an exhibition of contemporary Zimbabwean stone sculptures. ZimSculpt features the talent of several contemporary Zimbabwean artists with more than 100 hand-selected, exquisite sculptures artfully displayed throughout the garden.

Guests are welcome to bring their own food or purchase food onsite. Window food service is available at the Terrace Café presented by Gil’s Elegant Catering and includes a selection of soups, salads, sandwiches, snacks, drinks and adult beverages. Dollar Days food specials include \$1 sodas, juice and frozen pops, \$2 root beer floats and hotdogs, and \$4 brownie sundaes. Restaurant DeGolyer is also open for visitors daily from 11 am to 2 pm. A three course seated tea at 11 am and 2 pm is also available with advanced registration.

The Dallas Arboretum has created a one-mile path and other leisurely walking paths around the garden to make it easy to tour. Guests can also enjoy respite in the shade of the Pecan Grove and Palmer Fern Dell, splash in Toad Corners, the Jonsson Color Garden, on the Camp House Lawn and the lawn of the Lay Family Garden. Grapevine Vintage Railroad Excursion

This excursion starts in Downtown Grapevine at the Cotton Belt Depot. Passengers will then ride along the rails on the historic Cotton Belt Route for 30 minutes before returning to the Grapevine Depot. It's perfect for families with small children or those who just want to get the experience of riding on a train.



Train robbers may also strike on the Tahwahkarro Creek Train Excursion which runs every Friday through August 13, departing Grapevine from the Historic Cotton Belt Depot at 11 am, 1:30 pm and 3:30 pm. Passengers will ride along the historic Cotton Belt Route before returning to Historic Grapevine.

Families with small children may also enjoy a round-trip ride on the Trinity River Train Excursion which originates at the Historic Fort Worth Stockyards and travels along the Cotton Belt Route. The Trinity River Excursion runs every Saturday and Sunday through August 15, departing at approximately 3 pm and returning to the Stockyards at approximately 3:45 pm. This excursion does not travel to Grapevine.

Please note that passengers do not de-board the train during the ride. The train will reverse direction on the tracks to return to Grapevine. This excursion does not travel to the Fort Worth Stockyards.

PRICING:

First Class - \$12 (all ages)

The Grapevine Vintage Railroad has four First Class coaches. These coaches have Victorian-upholstered seats, complete with turn of the century ambiance and are fully climate-controlled for year round passenger comfort.

Touring Class - \$11 (all ages)

The Touring Class coach offers floor to ceiling views of the communities we travel through. These coaches are complete with padded seating and offers year round climate-control for passenger comfort.

Economy Class - \$10 (all ages)

Economy Class offers a true turn of the century railroad experience with open-air travel during the warmer months and are enclosed and heated during the colder months. These coaches are complete with vintage wooden bench-style seating.

NOTE: Due to federal regulations, children 13 months and older require a ticket and their own seat. Children 12 months and younger may ride for free, however they must ride in the lap or arms of a parent or guardian. For safety reasons children may not ride in a car seat or stroller while the train is in motion.

Please note that schedules - including departure times, return time, and days of operation - are tentative and are subject to change based on freight train delays, federal track maintenance, holidays or weather related closures. While the GVRR makes every attempt to adhere to posted schedules, please understand that delays in arrival times or sudden cancellations of a trip are beyond our control.

Events Coming Up in October for Halloween & Christmas Holiday with Radiance!

It's beginning to look like a hot, steamy end of summer—a perfect time to talk fall and winter holidays. The folks behind last year's smash-hit Radiance! Holiday Light Spectacular are back for 2021 and flipping the switch on dazzling new events for both Halloween and Christmas.

Radiance! A Holiday Light Spectacular will return to both Weatherford and Decatur for 2021, with an enhanced mile-long drive-thru holiday experience. They're adding more scenes, a million more dazzling animated lights, and VIP experiences that include exclusive light tunnel photo opportunities and faster access. **Radiance! at the Ranch in Weatherford** (Parker County Sheriff's Posse, 2251 Mineral Wells Hwy.) will run November 18-December 31, while **Radiance! Decatur** (Reunion Grounds Joe Wheeler Park, 2901 FM 51 #100) will run November 18-December 26. A new location—aptly named **Radiance! at the Races**—will launch this November at the Texas Motorplex in Ennis (7500 US-287) and give guests the chance to drive along “a dragster track arched with animated tunnels, racing-themed holiday scenes, and dancing lights galore.” It will run November 18-January 1.

Across town in Frisco, the fun gets started as early as Halloween. First there'll be a brand-new, family-friendly Halloween event, **Frights'n Lights Frisco**, “where ghouls glow, spirits shine, and things go ‘bump’ in the light!” says the release. “Bridging the gap between basic pumpkin patches and the gore of traditional haunted houses, Frights'n Lights is an Instagram wonderland chock full of ‘phantasmic’ photo opportunities and features the largest and safest trick-or-treat trail in Texas.” They promise a land filled with thousands of shining, intricately carved jack-o-lanterns and a thrilling cast of spine-chilling Hollywood stars brought to life by a ghoulish gallery of giant-sized lanterns and lights. There'll also be haunted games, the Headless Horseman's Haunted Hay Maze, rides, Halloween-themed concessions, and a retro drive-in movie on a 40-foot screen, they say. The event will take place at Riders Field (formerly Dr Pepper Ballpark) in Frisco, on select dates from September 30-November 6. Tickets will go on sale in September; prices have not been disclosed.

Then will come **Radiance! featuring Frozen** in Frisco, “a magnificent winter carnival sure to fill every member of your family with the spirit of the season,” they promise. Running November 18-January 6 at Frisco's Riders Field, it's a two-part experience covered by one ticket. **Radiance!**, held as a drive-thru event last year, becomes a theme park-style ride in a vehicle that guides guests through the show. Visitors can expect an all-new, mile-long light trail of over 3 million RGB lights, animated to favorite holiday tunes, leading into the inaugural **Frozen in Frisco** winter-themed festival. The event will feature a two-story outdoor ice tubing hill, ice skating under the stars, bumper cars on ice, snowball toss with real snow, a 108-foot Ferris wheel, Christmas carousel, buckin' reindeer rides, a Christmas Story escape room, s'mores fire pits, a holiday market, and more.
