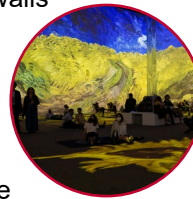

Vincent Van Gogh in Dallas

Being surrounded by moving images conjured from the iconic Dutch artist's colorful, swirling paintings has become such a worldwide phenomenon that about a dozen different productions are on tour. "Immersive Van Gogh" was the first to land in Dallas. Running through Oct. 31 at Lighthouse Artspace Dallas, it is a 40-minute show with 100 video projectors displaying several of Van Gogh's best-known paintings, including *The Starry Night*, unfurled along the walls and floors, set to rousing music. A second show produced by one of the other companies taking advantage of the artist's popularity, "Van Gogh: The Immersive Experience," opened Aug. 19 at Globe Life Park in Arlington. Coincidentally, an exhibit of Van Gogh's olive grove painting series is coming to the Dallas Museum of Art later this year. "Van Gogh and the Olive Groves" will be the first exhibition to reunite all 15 paintings in the series executed during his stay at the asylum of Saint-Rémy-de-Provence. This collaboration between the DMA and the Van Gogh Museum in Amsterdam will demonstrate new discoveries through conservation and scientific research. The museum has planned several pop-up experiences before the exhibit opens Oct. 1.

Autumn at the Arboretum:

Sept. 18 - Oct. 31

Autumn at the Arboretum, the Southwest's favorite fall festival, runs September 18 through October 31, 2021. Though the festival ends on Halloween, the Pumpkin Village remains open through Thanksgiving weekend. The 16th annual Autumn at the Arboretum, presented by Reliant, returns with more than 90,000 pumpkins, gourds and squash, hailing from THE pumpkin capital of Texas, Floydada, throughout the garden. New this year is the location of the nationally acclaimed Pumpkin Village - behind the Jonsson Color Garden transformed into the theme Bugtopia. The signature display comes alive with larger-than-life insect topiaries, fascinatingly bugged-out pumpkin houses, and, of course, a maze for younger visitors. Special events, live music and Halloween festivities round out this favorite fall festival.

State Fair of Texas: Sept 24-Oct 17

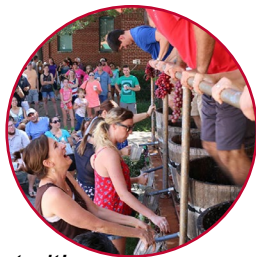

Addison Oktoberfest: September 16-19

Addison Oktoberfest has been recognized as one of the most authentic Oktoberfest celebrations outside of Munich for over three decades. This year, there will be no celebration in Munich because of the pandemic. So, when more than 50,000 fans come together in Addison Circle Park to share a love of polka, German food and, of course, the same Paulaner Bier that is normally served at Bavaria's favorite festival, it will be the best Oktoberfest experience anyone can have in 2021.

Dozens of polka bands and other traditional entertainers from around the country perform with continuous entertainment on multiple stages, including one at the Partyhalle, a 30,000-square-foot open-air tent with seating for 1,500. Oktoberfest guests, who visit Addison from all over the Southwest and beyond, will enjoy fun contests such as dachshund races, bier barrel rolling, a German Idol yodeling contest, and more. The event offers fun for all ages, with special activities for kids, and unique shopping opportunities in the Marktplatz. Don't forget your dirndl and lederhosen – dressing for the occasion is enthusiastically encouraged.



Make an Oktoberfest weekend of it: Book an Addison Oktoberfest Hotel Package, which includes lodging, two event admission tickets, two souvenir pins, two commemorative steins and two Paulaner beers – but book early, packages are limited.

The Town of Addison will be taking enhanced measures to promote a safe gathering. Face coverings are strongly recommended for attendees who have not been vaccinated for COVID-19. New for 2021, food vendors will offer mobile ordering to promote social distancing and reduce waiting in lines. While often questioned about hosting a festival called Oktoberfest during the month of September, Addison times its festival to open the same weekend as the Munich celebration traditionally does. The free 3-day, Deep Ellum Arts Festival® in Downtown Dallas embodies everything that makes DFW rock. Experience more than 200 juried decorative and visual artists selling and commissioning original works, and 100 original bands and performers artists showcasing the newest sights and sounds from six different stages and two additional performance areas!

This is an “adult-oriented” visual and performing arts festival; while supervised young children and teenagers are welcome during the day, there are no specifically planned activities for them.

Seven blocks of Main Street in the Dallas entertainment district of Deep Ellum, 2900-3700 Main Street, Dallas, TX 75226, will be transformed into one enormous street festival. Featuring 200 top-notch decorative and visual artists, 100 original bands and singer/songwriters performing from four different stages and two additional performance areas, The Artists in Motion Walk, and enticing foods and drinks.

Festival attendees can stroll through displays of cutting-edge decorative arts and admire, commission, and purchase the works of sculptors, muralists, jewelers, painters, leather and wood crafters, as well as other specialized fine artists, some of whom will be creating original pieces on the spot.
