The DFW Dragon Boat, Kite, and Lantern Festival is a family-friendly event held at the Las Colinas Urban Center on the banks of Lake Carolyn in Irving, Texas. A



presentation of the Marco Polo World Foundation to showcase and celebrate multicultural arts and sports as part of Asian-Pacific American Heritage Month, the day-long festival features exciting dragon boat races, kite and lantern making, music and dance, food, and much more.

Parking: Ride DART to Las Colinas Urban Center Station and the free APT Transit System will take you to the festival site. Parking is also available at nearby garages for a fee.

The DFW Dragon Boat Festival is a food event as well. You'll have your pick of Thai, Chinese, Japanese, Korean, American, Barbecue, Indian, Mexican, Italian, and so much more. Bring your appetite for a feast of traditional and fusion cuisines.

Throughout the day-long festival, enjoy traditional dance and music performances from different Pacific Island, South and East Asian, and other international traditions. Plus, watch martial arts showcases by area schools. The festival also welcomes local city, state, national, and international dignitaries who share in the festivities.

## Lightscape 2022

We are beyond ecstatic to announce that Lightscape is making its debut in Fort Worth during the 2022 holiday season, and that North Texans will have the opportunity to experience this internationally renowned holiday light show at the Fort Worth Botanic Garden for the first time ever,” says Patrick Newman, CEO & president of the Fort Worth Botanic Garden, in a June 8 news release. “Following sold-out shows in cities across the world, we look forward to transforming the Garden into an enchanting after-dark spectacular like no other.”

According to the release, visitors can expect to walk a one-mile-long path with suspended strands and tunnels of light, a fire garden, undulating wave of bluebonnets, singing trees, treetop sculptures, and artistic installations. They’ll also get to toast marshmallows over a fire and drink hot chocolate and other seasonal drinks at stations along the trail.

The winter wonderland will all take place within the 120-acre Fort Worth Botanic Garden campus, and the illuminated walking trail will be custom-designed for Fort Worth. It will open November 18, 2022 and run through January 8, 2023.

It is produced by the Fort Worth Botanic Garden in association with Sony Music, creatively produced by Culture Creative, and promoted in partnership with WAD Entertainment, the release touts.

Lightscape has enjoyed sold-out runs in the world’s largest cities including London, Chicago, Los Angeles, and New York. It got a presentation in Houston last year, and was considered one of the city’s top holiday attractions. It was such a hit in San Antonio last year, it’s returning for 2022. Surely it’ll make CultureMap Fort Worth’s annual list of the most specular holiday lights, too.

Tickets to the family-friendly Fort Worth event will be required, with entry times available every 15 minutes from 5:45 pm to 9 pm nightly. (The average tour time from start to finish is 1.5 hours, although there is no time limit, they say.)

Tickets run \$28 for adults, \$18 for children (ages 3-12), and free for infants (0-2 years old). FWBG members receive \$5 off of each ticket. Note that these are day-of prices; they’re slightly cheaper purchased in advance, according to the website, but each ticket carries a \$3 service fee. Prices also do not include parking, which runs \$15-\$20, according to the website. A \$60 VIP ticket package includes parking.
