The Heard Museum and Wildlife Sanctuary is a fabulous outing for- family and friend groups, nature photographers, and all ages for life science school field trips

While the Heard Natural Science Museum & Wildlife Sanctuary offers educational exhibits and programs to better help our visitors connect with nature, the Heard is a "nature preserve" rather than a "park." Our mission to bring nature and people together to promote an interest in preserving nature. And, as such, our Wildlife Sanctuary also functions as a nature preserve.

The primary focus of a nature preserve is to maintain and/or restore its native ecological conditions in order to protect the land and its native plants and wildlife. In general, while our nature preserve is open to the public for hiking and educational opportunities, we do not offer as wide of a variety of recreational opportunities as you might see at a typical park.

The activities we offer within the preserve are limited so as to prevent deterioration of the land and the plants and animals living on it. For example, this is why we ask all visitors to stay on the trails. Additionally, as a nonprofit nature preserve, we have few paid staff to pick up litter and perform other maintenance tasks.
