Created by Dallas native Dustin Ballard, the project is known for genre-bending, expectation-shattering rearrangements that "lovingly destroy your favorite songs," earning attention from artists like Ed Sheeran, Snoop Dogg and Weird Al Yankovic.

The live band brings the channel's most notorious creations to life with the help of Ballard and 7 top DFW musicians, blending musicianship and humor into one of the most unique live shows you'll see all year.
